

Max the Monkey's Addition Adventure

Learning objective: To practise adding two and three-digit numbers using mental and written methods.

Read the front of the flashcard to see the challenge. Try to solve the addition problem or answer the question before checking the back for the correct answer.

Max has 45 bananas and finds 24 more. What is the total sum?

69

What does 'regrouping' mean in column addition?

When the digits in a column add up to 10 or more, you carry the ten over to the next column.

Calculate: $126 + 153$

279

If you buy a book for £4.50 and a pen for £1.20, what is the total cost?

£5.70

Use partitioning to solve: $34 + 25$.

$30 + 20 = 50$ and $4 + 5 = 9$, so $50 + 9 = 59$.

What is the sum of 400 and 350?

750

Max has £3.25. His friend gives him £2.50. How much money does he have now?

£5.75

True or False: When adding, the order of the numbers does not change the total.

True (this is the commutative law).

Calculate: $508 + 101$

609

If you have 215 stickers and receive 100 more, how many do you have?

315

Max adds $60 + 70$. What is the total?

130

What is the term for the answer to an addition problem?

The sum or total.
