Learning objective: To practise adding whole numbers with more than four digits using formal written methods (column addition).

Read the challenge on the front of the card. Use a piece of paper to work out the calculation using the column addition method, then flip to check your answer.

Max has 12,450 acorns and finds 8,375 more. What is the total?	What is the sum of 45,678 and 23,456?
