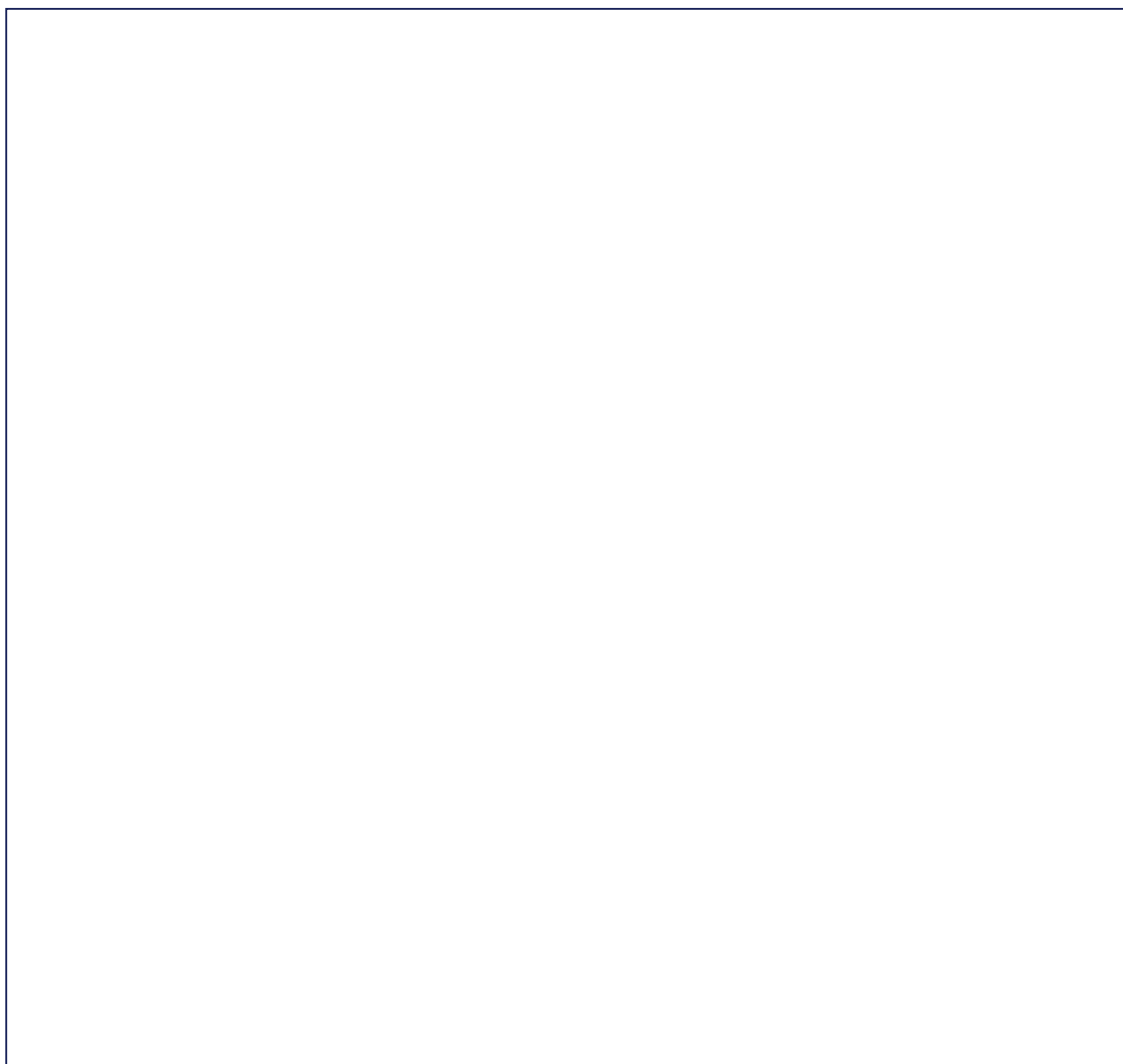


Max's Christmas Market Maths

Learning objective: To solve addition and subtraction problems involving money (£) in a festive context.

Help Max the monkey work out the total cost of his Christmas market treats! Colour the picture neatly and answer the labelling questions below to show your working out.

Colour this: A festive outdoor scene featuring Max the monkey wearing a colourful woolly scarf. Max is standing in front of a wooden market stall. On the stall, draw a large gingerbread star with a '40p' tag, a candy cane with a '30p' tag, and a small basket. Include simple geometric shapes in the background like round baubles on a tree and square gift boxes with bows. The lines should be bold and clear for colouring. Ensure the price tags are empty so the children can fill in their answers.



Steps:

1. Max buys a gingerbread star for 40p and a candy cane for 30p. Label the total cost in the empty star shape next to Max.
2. Max has £1. He spends 70p on snacks. Label the amount of change he has left in the basket on the

ground.
