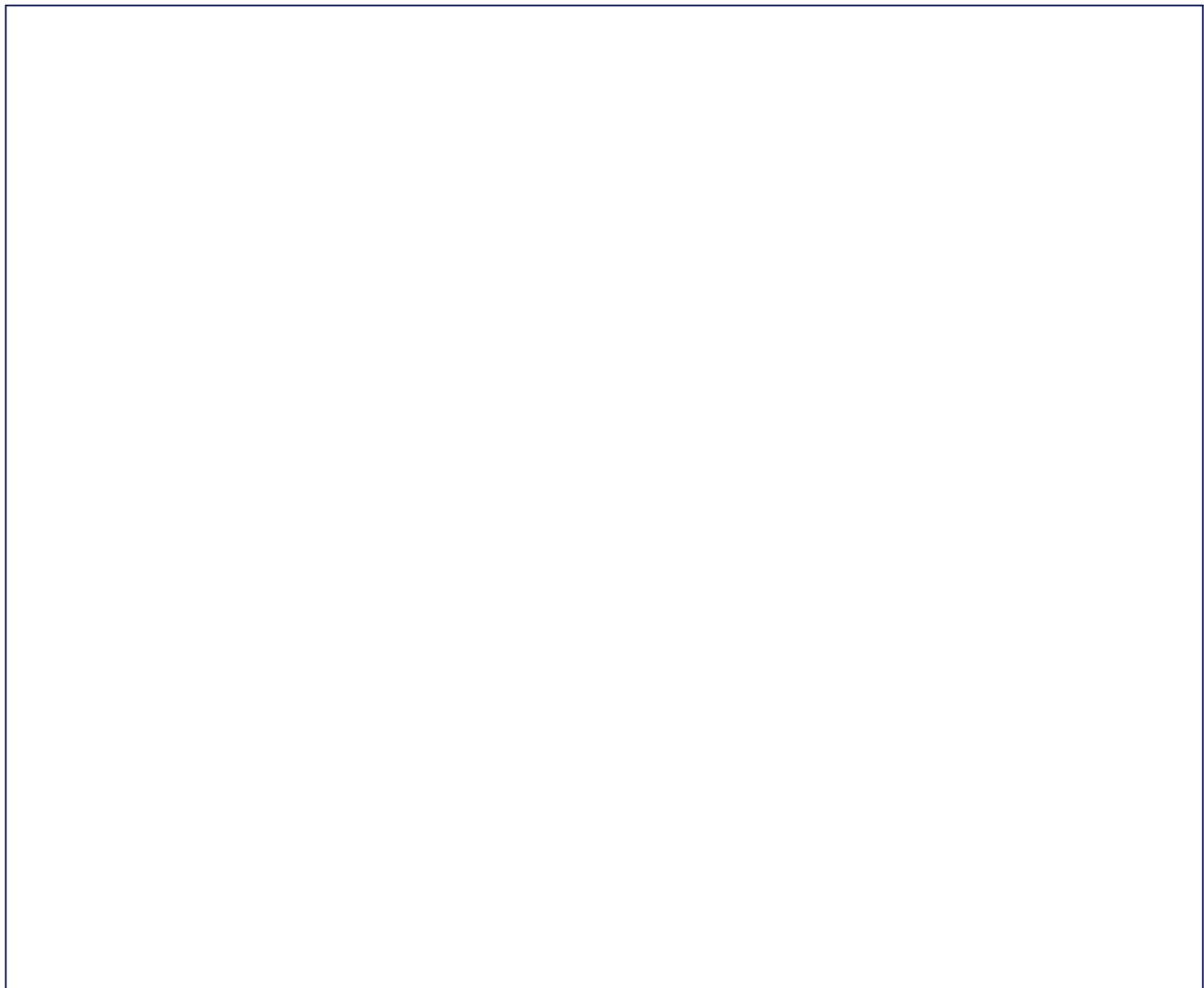


Max's Christmas Market Maths

Learning objective: To apply addition, subtraction, and multiplication skills to solve Christmas-themed money problems.

Help Max the monkey organise his Christmas market stall! Read the questions carefully, perform your calculations, and draw the items as requested to complete your market display.

Draw: Draw a large, decorated Christmas tree in the centre of your page. Around the tree, draw 3 boxes labelled '£4' and 2 rolls of tinsel. Draw Max the monkey standing next to the tree holding a price list. The style should be clean and festive, using clear lines so you can label your items using the word bank.



Label words: Baubles · Tinsel · Price tag · Stock · Total cost · Change · Christmas tree

Steps:

1. Max sells 3 boxes of baubles for £4 each. How much money does he make from the baubles? Show your working.
2. If a customer buys 2 rolls of tinsel at £3 each, what is the total cost of the tinsel?
3. The customer gives Max a £10 note to pay for the £6 worth of tinsel. How much change should Max give back?
4. Max wants to add 5 more baubles to his tree. If each bauble costs £2, how much will the extra baubles

cost in total?

5. If Max has £20 in his tin and spends £12 on new decorations, how much money does he have left?
