

Max's Division Discovery Flashcards

Learning objective: To understand division as sharing objects into equal groups and to solve division problems using £ and standard numbers.

Read the front of the card to yourself. Try to work out the answer before flipping it over to check your work with Max the monkey!

What does it mean to divide?	Max has 10 bananas. He shares them equally between 2 monkeys. How many bananas does each monkey get?
To share a total amount into equal groups.	5 bananas.
If you have 12 stickers and share them into 3 equal piles, how many stickers are in each pile?	True or False: When we divide, the groups must be equal in size.
4 stickers.	True.
Max has £8. He wants to share it equally between 4 friends. How much money does each friend get?	Solve: $15 \div 5 = ?$
£2.	3.
If you have 20p and share it equally between 2 children, how much does each child get?	Max has 9 apples. He puts them into bags of 3. How many bags does he need?
10p.	3 bags.
What is the symbol for division?	Solve: $16 \div 2 = ?$
÷	8.
If you have 10 socks and share them into pairs (groups of 2), how many pairs do you have?	Max has £20 and shares it between 5 boxes. How much money is in each box?
5 pairs.	£4.
