

Max's Magnificent Division Station!

Jump into division with Max the Monkey—sharing is caring and maths is fun!

- **Division is when we share a large number into equal groups. If we have 10 sweets and share them between 2 children, each child gets 5.**
- **The division sign looks like this: $\div$. It shows us that we are splitting a total amount into smaller, equal parts.**
- **You can use an array to help you divide! An array is a neat pattern of dots or objects in rows and columns that makes counting easier.**
- **If you have 15 coins (£) and you put them into groups of 5, you will have 3 equal groups. $15 \div 5 = 3$.**
- **Sometimes, when we share, there is a little bit left over that doesn't fit into a group. We call this a remainder!**

Did you know? Did you know? Division is the opposite of multiplication! If you have 12 bananas and share them equally between 3 monkeys, each monkey gets 4 bananas. Maths helps us make sure everyone gets a fair treat!
