Learning objective: To recall and use division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 multiplication tables, including recognising odd and even numbers.

1. 1. Max has 10 bananas. He shares them equally between 2 monkeys. How many bananas does each monkey get? A) 3 B) 5* C) 2 D) 10 (1 mark)

2. 2. Calculate $12 \div 3 = ?$ (1 mark)

3. 3. True or False: Dividing by 2 is the same as finding half of a number. (1 mark)

4. 4. Zara has 20 stickers. She puts them into 4 equal rows. How many stickers are in each row? A) 6 B) 3 C) 5* D) 4 (1 mark)

5. 5. What is $25 \div 5$? (1 mark)

6. 6. True or False: $15 \div 2 = 7$ with no remainder. (1 mark)

7. 7. If you have 30p and you share it equally among 10 friends, how many pence does each friend get? (1 mark)

8. 8. Which calculation shows 16 shared into 2 equal groups? A) $16 \div 2 = 8$ * B) $16 \div 4 = 4$ C) $16 \div 8 = 2$ D) $16 - 2 = 14$ (1 mark)

9. 9. Complete this: $100 \div 10 = ?$ (1 mark)

10. 10. True or False: Division is the opposite of multiplication. (1 mark)
