

Max's Egg-cellent Easter Maths Adventure

Hop into maths and help Max solve these spring-time puzzles!

- Max found 5 blue eggs and 4 yellow eggs. To find the total, we use addition: $5 + 4 = 9$ eggs altogether.
- If you have 10p and buy a chocolate treat for 6p, you can find the change by using subtraction: $10p - 6p = 4p$ left.
- A basket costs £2 and a ribbon costs £1. To find the total cost, we add them together: $£2 + £1 = £3$.
- Max has 8 eggs in his basket. He gives 3 to his friend. Now he has 5 eggs left: $8 - 3 = 5$.
- If one small gift costs 50p, then two of those gifts cost £1 because $50p + 50p = 100p$, which is the same as £1.
- Counting in 2s helps us count pairs of eggs quickly! 2, 4, 6, 8, 10... look how fast we can count!

Did you know? Did you know? In the spring, many animals wake up from a long sleep called hibernation. Max the monkey loves spring because it is the perfect time to count colourful eggs hidden in the garden!
