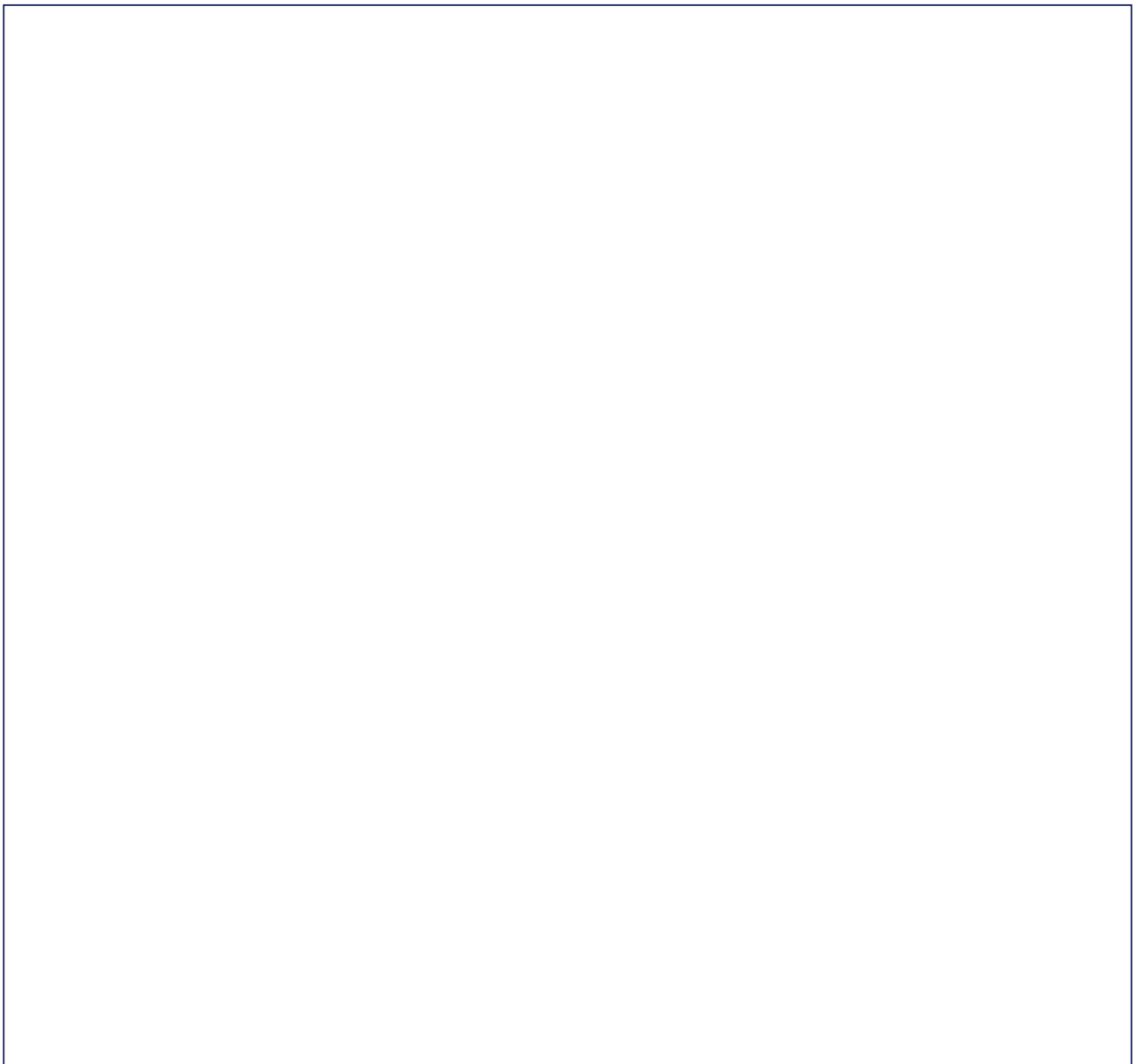


Max's Market Measurement Adventure

Learning objective: To measure and compare lengths and heights using standard units (centimetres).

Help Max the monkey organise his market stall! Measure the items drawn on the page using a ruler, then colour the picture to make the market look bright and cheerful.

Colour this: A large, friendly monkey named Max wearing a small apron stands behind a wooden market stall. On the stall, there are several items to be measured: a tall sunflower in a pot, a bunch of three bananas, a single round apple, and a straight ruler lying flat on the table. The lines of the objects should be clear and thick for colouring. In the background, draw a simple sunny sky and some fluffy clouds. Ensure there is plenty of white space around the items so children can write their measurements next to them.



Steps:

1. Label the longest fruit in the picture with its length in centimetres.
2. Label the measuring tool Max is holding in his hand.
