

Max's Magnificent Measurement Guide

Get ready to measure with Max the Maths Monkey – let's make sense of the world!

- **Length:** We use centimetres (cm) for short objects and metres (m) for long distances. 100cm is exactly the same as 1m.
- **Mass:** We weigh objects in grams (g) or kilograms (kg). There are 1,000 grams in 1 kilogram.
- **Capacity:** This is how much liquid a container holds. We use millilitres (ml) for small amounts and litres (l) for larger amounts.
- **Temperature:** We measure how hot or cold something is using a thermometer. We record this in degrees Celsius (°C).
- **Money Matters:** We use pounds (£) and pence (p) to measure the value of items. Remember, 100p makes £1.

Did you know? Did you know? Even though Max the monkey loves bananas, he knows that a large bunch of bananas weighs about 1 kilogram! Measurement helps us share things fairly and build amazing structures.
