- We have 1p, 2p, 5p, 10p, 20p, and 50p coins. The 'p' stands for pence.
- The £1 and £2 coins are larger than the small silver coins.
- We use notes for larger amounts, like the £5 note and the £10 note.
- One pound (£1) is exactly the same as 100 pence (100p).
- If you have 5p and 2p, you have 7p altogether. Max loves adding them up!
- When you buy something, you swap your money for the item you want.

Did you know? Did you know? Before we had metal coins, people used to trade things like shells, salt, or shiny stones to get the items they needed! Now, we use coins and notes to help us buy things easily.
