2. 2. True or False: £1 is worth the same as 5p. (1 mark)

3. 3. Max has two 1p coins. How much does he have in total? (Answer in p) (1 mark)

4. 4. Which coin is a silver pound coin? A) 5p B) £1* C) 2p D) 10p (1 mark)

5. 5. True or False: A 20p coin is worth more than a 2p coin. (1 mark)

6. 6. If Max has a 2p coin and a 3p coin, how much money does he have altogether? (Answer in p) (1 mark)

7. 7. How many pence are in a 10p coin? (1 mark)

8. 8. True or False: We use the symbol £ for pounds. (1 mark)

9. 9. Max has two 10p coins. What is the total value in pence? (1 mark)

10. 10. True or False: All coins are the same size and colour. (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a picture of Max the Monkey holding his favourite shiny £1 coin in one hand and a 5p coin in the other.



Extension challenge: Max wants to buy a banana that costs 12p. If he only has 10p coins and 1p coins, how many of each could he use to pay exactly 12p?
