Learning objective: To recognise, count and compare British coins and notes, and solve simple problems involving addition and subtraction of money.

Use these flashcards to practise your money skills. Read the front of the card, try to solve the puzzle, then check your answer on the back!

What is the value of the smallest copper coin in the UK?

1p (one penny).

Max has a 20p coin and a 5p coin. What is the total?

25p.

Which is worth more: a £2 coin or a 50p coin?

A £2 coin.

How many 10p coins do you need to make £1?

10 coins.

Ellie buys a sticker for 30p. She pays with a 50p coin. How much change does she get?

20p.

How many 5p coins make 20p?

4 coins.

What colour is the £2 coin?

It is bimetallic (gold-coloured in the middle and silver-coloured on the outside).

If you have two £5 notes, how much money do you have in total?

£10.

True or False: 100p is the same as £1.

True.

Kit finds a 2p coin and a 2p coin. How much does he have?

4p.

Which coin is larger in size: a 2p coin or a 5p coin?

A 2p coin.

If a pencil costs 40p, how much more do you need to make 50p?

10p.
