

Max's Money Mastery Flashcards

Learning objective: To develop fluency in adding, subtracting, and calculating with pounds (£) and pence (p) in real-world contexts.

Use these flashcards to practice your maths skills with Max the monkey. Read the question on the front, work out the answer, then flip to check if you are right!

How many pence are in £1?	If Max buys a banana for 40p and an apple for 30p, what is the total cost?
100p	70p
Write £2 and 50p using a decimal point.	You have £1.00 and spend 60p. How much change do you get?
£2.50	40p
Which is more: 95p or £1.05?	Max has three 20p coins. How much money does he have in total?
£1.05	60p
If a notebook costs £3 and you pay with a £5 note, what is your change?	How many 10p coins make £1?
£2	10 coins
Max finds 50p and 20p in his pocket. Does he have enough to buy a sandwich costing 80p?	What is 40p + 80p? Give your answer in pounds and pence.
No (he only has 70p)	£1.20
True or False: £0.50 is the same as 50p.	You have £2.00. You buy a sticker for 30p and a pen for 50p. How much have you spent?
True	80p
