A pack of 5 notebooks costs £7.50. What is the unit price of one notebook?

£1.50

Ellie buys a history book for £8.99 and a bookmark for £1.20. What is the total cost?

£10.19

If your weekly income is £15.00 and you save £3.50, how much can you spend?

£11.50

How many 20p coins make up £2.00?

10 coins

Pip buys a pen for £2.50 and sells it for £3.75. What is the profit?

£1.25

Zara has four £5 notes and three £2 coins. How much money does she have in total?

£26.00

If a train ticket costs £12.60 and you pay with a £20 note, what is your change?

£7.40
