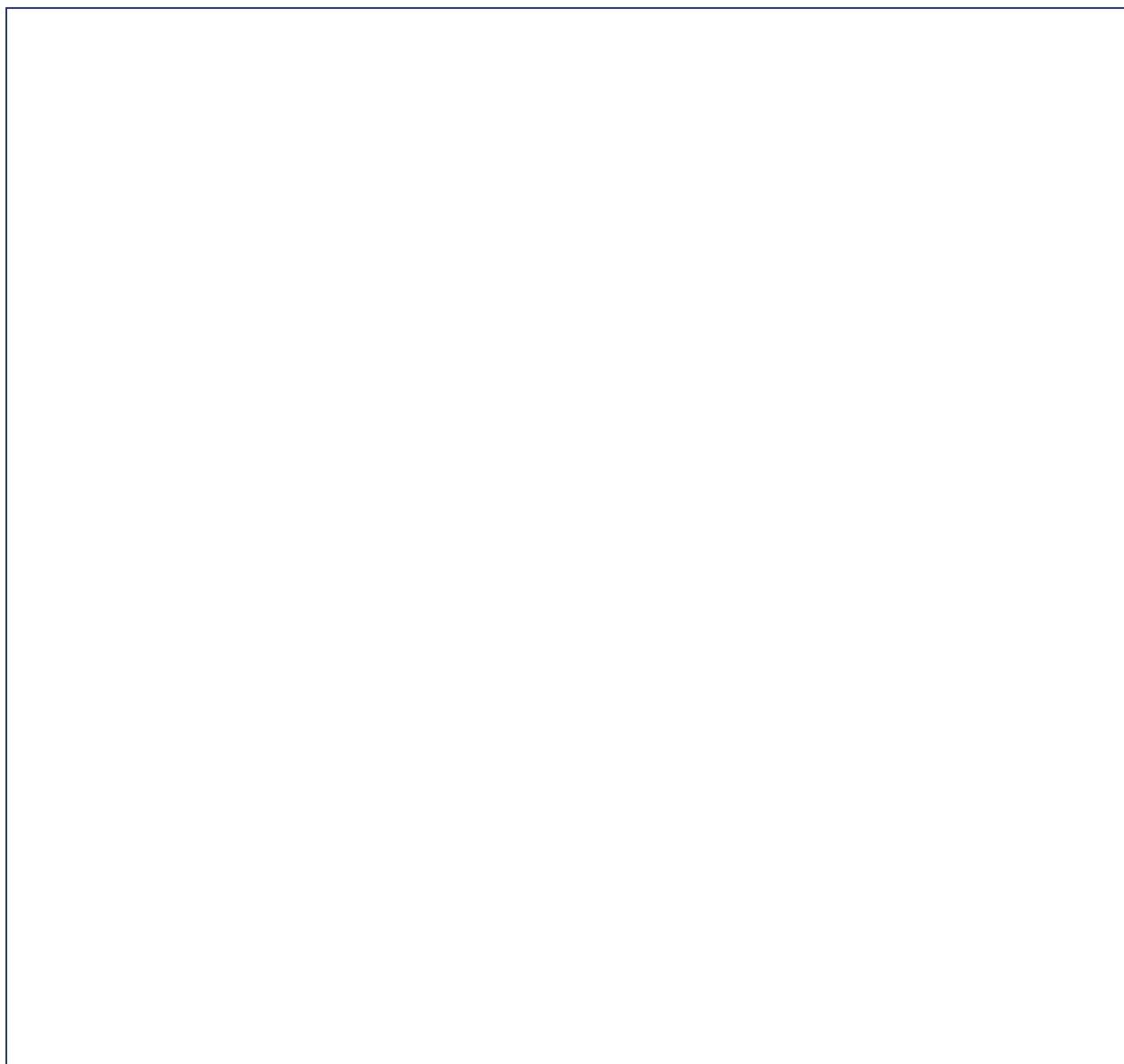


Max's Market Multiplication

Learning objective: To recall and use multiplication facts for the 2, 5 and 10 multiplication tables.

Help Max the monkey organise his market stall! Calculate the total cost of the items by multiplying the price of one item by the number of items. Colour in the fruit and the price tags as you solve each problem.

Colour this: A friendly monkey named Max wearing an apron, standing behind a market stall. On the stall are three baskets, each containing 5 pears, and four bunches of bananas, each containing 2 bananas. Next to the pear baskets, draw a blank sign shaped like a star to write the total cost (£15). Next to the banana bunches, draw a blank sign shaped like a circle to write the total cost (£8). Use thick, clear outlines suitable for colouring.



Steps:

1. Max has 3 baskets of pears. Each basket costs £5. Label the total cost of the pears on the basket.
2. Max has 4 bunches of bananas. Each bunch costs £2. Label the total cost of the bananas on the bunch.
