

# Max the Monkey's Rounding Adventure

*Learning objective: To round numbers to the nearest 10 and 100, and to understand the rules of rounding.*

Help Max the Monkey solve his maths puzzles! Read the front of each card, think about the rounding rule, and then flip to see the answer. Remember: if the digit is 5 or more, round up to the next ten or hundred!

What does it mean to 'round' a number?

To make a number simpler to work with by keeping its value close to the original number.

Round 32 to the nearest 10.

30

Round 67 to the nearest 10.

70

If a number ends in 5, do you round up or down?

Round up to the next ten or hundred.

Round 145 to the nearest 10.

150

Round 210 to the nearest 100.

200

Round 480 to the nearest 100.

500

Max has 86p. Round his money to the nearest £1.

£1

Round 750 to the nearest 100.

800

Is 34 closer to 30 or 40?

30

Round 92 to the nearest 10.

90

Round 550 to the nearest 100.
