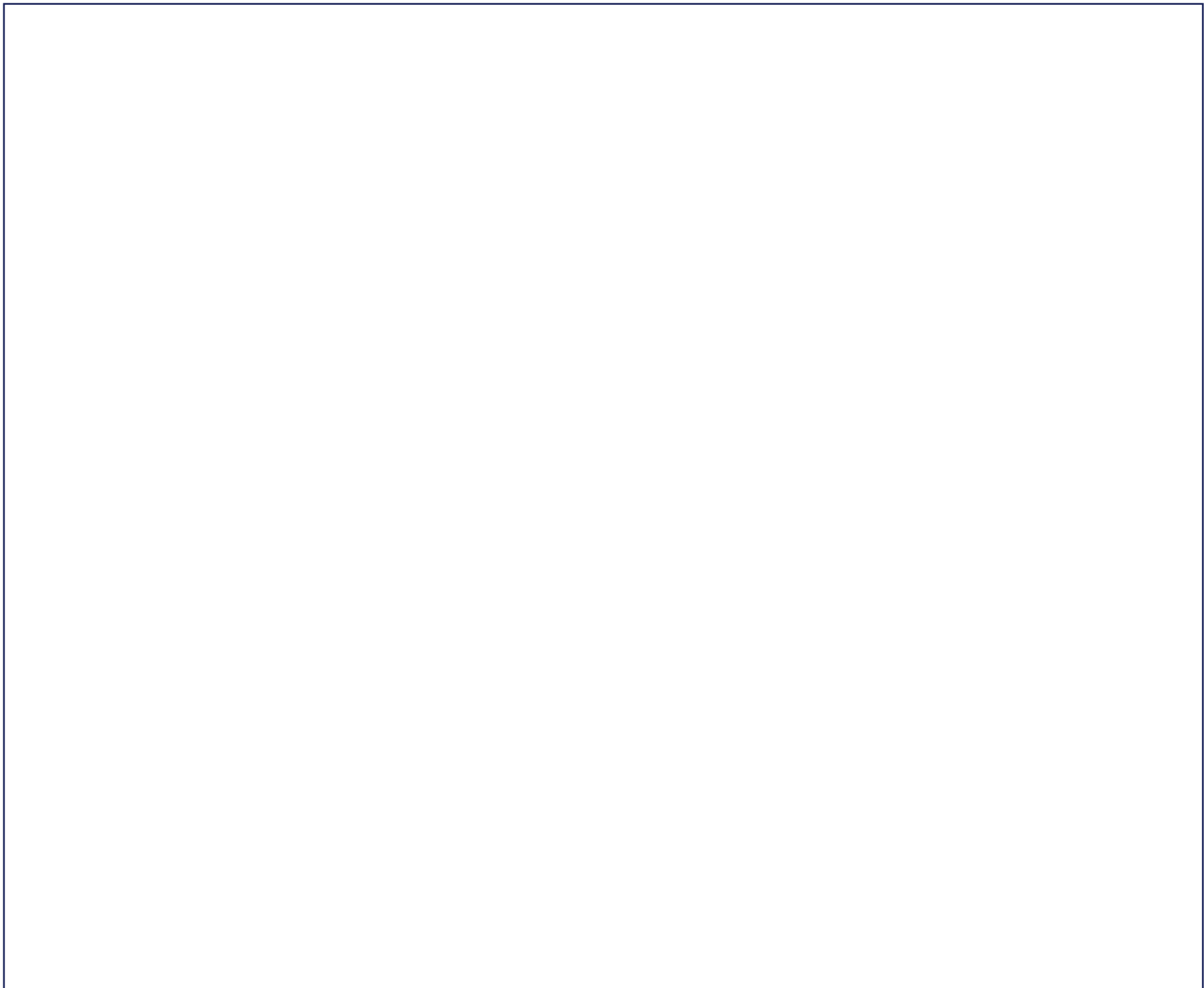


Max's Shape Safari

Learning objective: To identify, describe, and draw 2D and 3D shapes in a real-world setting.

Follow the drawing prompt below to help Max the monkey build a colourful playground. Use your ruler to make your lines neat and remember to label your shapes using the word bank.

Draw: Draw a large, colourful playground scene. In the centre, place a cube-shaped climbing tower. To the left, draw a slide with a right-angled triangle side. Under the tower, add a sphere-shaped ball pit. Add a pentagon-shaped sign near the entrance that says 'Max's Park'. Finally, draw a tunnel made from a cylinder lying on its side. Use a ruler for all straight edges.



Label words: cylinder · right angle · cube · parallel lines · pentagon · sphere

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a slide that has a side shaped like a right-angled triangle. Label the right angle.
2. Step 2: Draw a tower that is a cube. How many faces does your cube have?
3. Step 3: Draw a ball pit using a sphere shape. Is a sphere a 2D or 3D shape?
4. Step 4: Draw a sign shaped like a pentagon to hang on the gate. How many sides does a pentagon have?
5. Step 5: Draw a tunnel using a cylinder. Label the circular face.
