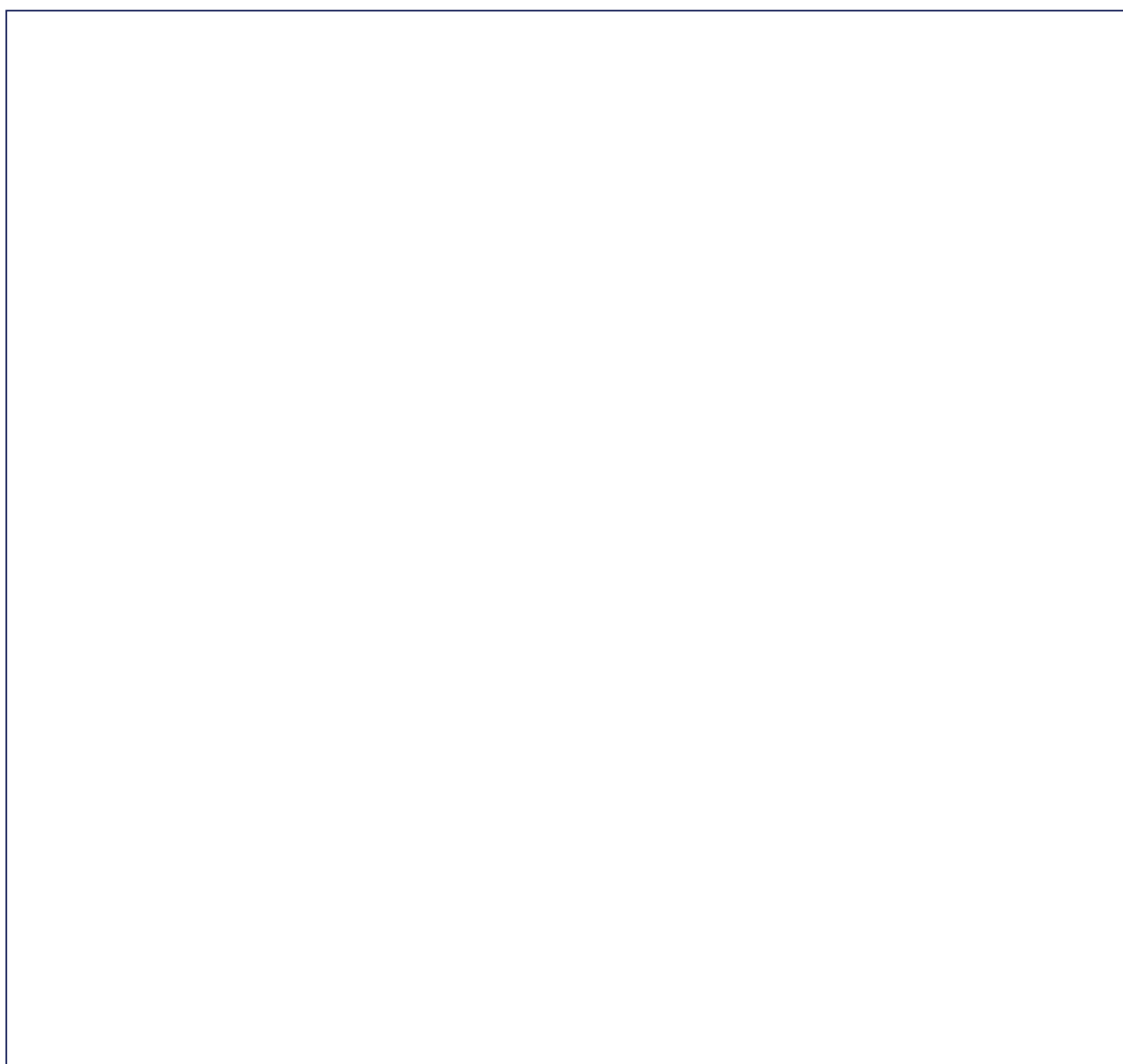


Max the Monkey's Market Subtraction

Learning objective: To solve subtraction calculations by finding the difference and calculating change within £20.

Help Max the monkey work out the change at the market! Colour the fruit, then solve the subtraction sums below the picture to find out how much money is left.

Colour this: A friendly monkey named Max wearing a small apron stands behind a wooden market stall. On the stall, there are three neat piles of fruit: a pile of 10 round apples, a bunch of 8 bananas, and a basket of 5 oranges. Beside the fruit, draw a small sign that says '£15' and another sign that says '£20'. Max is holding a pencil and a piece of paper with a subtraction sign (-) drawn on it. Steps:

1. Max has £15. He buys a bunch of bananas for £6. How much money does he have left? Show your working out.

2. Max has £20. He buys a bag of apples for £8. How much money does he have left?
3. Label the total amount of money Max started with in the first question.
