

Max's Busy Day: A Time-Telling Adventure

Learning objective: To tell and write the time from an analogue clock, including using Roman numerals and 12-hour clocks; to estimate and read time with increasing accuracy to the nearest minute.

Max the monkey is very busy! Look at the times on the clock faces below and fill in the blanks to describe his daily schedule. Use the word bank to help you spell your answers correctly. Make sure to use 'past' and 'to' when describing the time.

1. Max wakes up at 7:00. Write the time in words: _____. (1 mark)

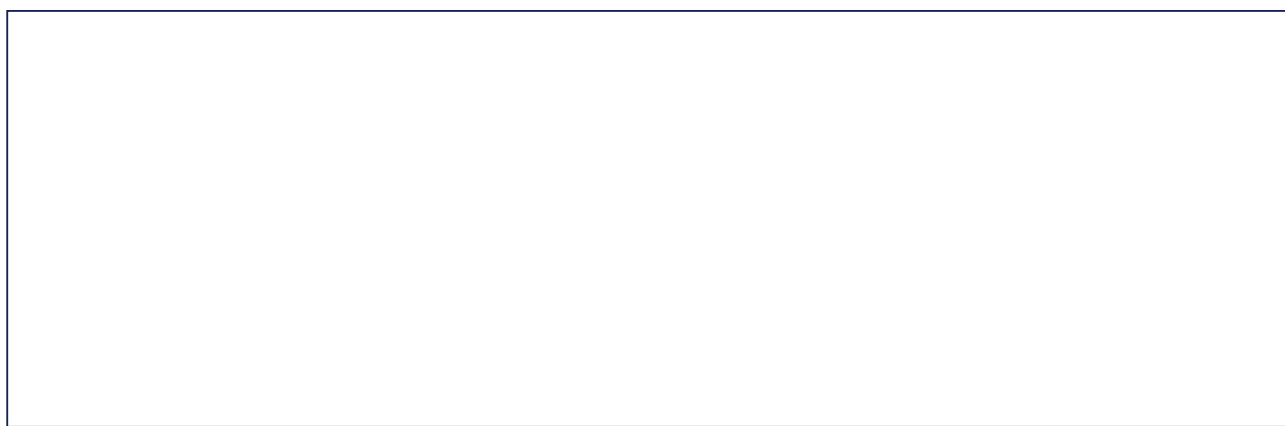
2. At 8:15, Max eats his breakfast. Write the time in words: _____. (1 mark)
