

Max the Monkey's Time-Telling Challenge

Learning objective: To tell and write the time from an analogue clock, including using Roman numerals from I to XII, and 12-hour and 24-hour clocks.

Read the front of each card to challenge yourself on telling the time. Flip the card to check if you got the answer right. Use these to practise with a partner!

Max the Monkey looks at his clock. The short hand is pointing at 3 and the long hand is at 12. What time is it?	If the long hand is on the 6 and the short hand is halfway between 4 and 5, what time is it?
3 o'clock	Half past 4
How many minutes are there in one full hour?	If the long hand points to the 3, what do we call this time?
60 minutes	Quarter past
If the long hand points to the 9, what do we call this time?	How many hours are there in one whole day?
Quarter to	24 hours
Max sees the clock show 12:00 when the sun is high in the sky. Is this midday or midnight?	On an analogue clock, what does the Roman numeral 'IX' represent?
Midday	9
If it is 2:15 pm, how many minutes past 2 is it?	How many seconds are there in one minute?
15 minutes past 2	60 seconds
Max started his maths puzzle at 9:00 and finished at 9:30. How many minutes did he spend working?	In 24-hour time, what is 1:00 pm written as?
30 minutes	13:00
