

Max's Magnificent Time Machine

Master the Minutes and Conquer the Clock with Max the Monkey!

- A day has 24 hours. There are 60 minutes in one hour and 60 seconds in one minute.
- The short hand on an analogue clock is the hour hand, and the long hand is the minute hand.
- When the long hand points to the 3, it is 'quarter past'. When it points to the 9, it is 'quarter to'.
- Roman numerals on a clock face use I for 1, V for 5, and X for 10. For example, 6 is VI and 12 is XII.
- To convert 12-hour time to 24-hour time in the afternoon, add 12 to the hour. 2:00 pm becomes 14:00.

Did you know? Did you know? In the past, people used sundials to tell the time by watching the shadow move as the Earth rotated! Today, we use precise clocks to make sure Max is never late for his maths puzzles.
