

Max the Monkey's Multiplication Market

Learning objective: To recall and use multiplication facts for the 2, 5, and 10 times tables.

3. Ellie buys 3 bunches of bananas. Each bunch costs £5. How much does Ellie spend in total? (Calculation: ____ x ____ = £____) (2 marks)

4. Zara buys 8 paintbrushes. Each paintbrush costs £2. How much does Zara spend in total? (Calculation: ____ x ____ = £____) (2 marks)

5. Kit buys 4 computer wires. Each wire costs £10. How much does Kit spend in total? (Calculation: ____ x ____ = £____) (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Max has £50 to spend at the market. If he buys 6 bags of peanuts for £5 each, how much money will he have left? Show your working out.
