Learning objective: To recall and use multiplication facts for the 2, 5, and 10 times tables.

Answer Key: 1) C (10), 2) B (25), 3) True, 4) 40, 5) 12, 6) A (20), 7) False, 8) 10, 9) 14, 10) 30. All questions are worth 1 mark each.

1. Max has 5 bunches of bananas. Each bunch has 2 bananas. How many bananas does he have in total? A) 7, B) 5, C) 10*, D) 12 (1 mark)

2. What is 5 multiplied by 5? A) 10, B) 25*, C) 15, D) 20 (1 mark)

3. True or False: 2×6 is the same as $6 + 6$. (1 mark)

4. If Max finds 4 packs of stickers with 10 stickers in each, how many stickers does he have? (Write your answer as a number) (1 mark)

5. What is the product of 2 and 6? (1 mark)

6. Which of these is the correct way to show 5×4 ? A) 20*, B) 15, C) 9, D) 25 (1 mark)

7. True or False: $10 \times 3 = 33$. (1 mark)

8. Max has 5 coins worth £2 each. How many pounds does he have in total? (1 mark)

9. What is 2×7 ? (1 mark)

10. If you have 6 groups of 5, what is the total? (1 mark)

Draw: Draw an array of 3 rows of 5 bananas to show the calculation $3 \times 5 = 15$.



Extension challenge: Max found 10 bags of marbles, and each bag has 5 marbles inside. Can you write the number sentence to show how many marbles Max has altogether?
