Learning objective: To recall and use multiplication facts for the 3, 4, and 8 multiplication tables.

1. Max has 8 bunches of bananas with 3 bananas in each bunch. How many bananas does he have in total? A) 18 B) 21 C) 24* D) 27 (1 mark)

2. True or False: 4×5 is the same as 5×4 . (1 mark)

3. What is 8 multiplied by 4? (1 mark)

4. Which of these is a multiple of 3? A) 14 B) 36* C) 25 D) 31 (1 mark)

5. True or False: $3 \times 9 = 24$. (1 mark)

6. If Max finds 6 boxes of mangoes and there are 4 in each box, how many mangoes are there altogether? (1 mark)

7. What is 10×8 ? A) 80* B) 18 C) 800 D) 88 (1 mark)

8. Fill in the missing number: $3 \times \underline{\quad} = 12$. (1 mark)

9. True or False: All multiples of 8 are also even numbers. (1 mark)

10. What is the product of 3 and 10? (1 mark)

Draw: Draw Max the Monkey holding a basket of fruit. Can you draw an array of 12 oranges in his basket, arranged in 3 rows of 4?



Extension challenge: Max bought 3 notebooks for £4 each. How much did he spend in total? Write down the multiplication sum you used to find the answer.
