

Year 4 PE Assessment: Invasion Games with Max the Monkey

Learning objective: To demonstrate knowledge of tactics, rules, and skills used in invasion games.

Read each question carefully. Max the Monkey needs your help to solve these sports puzzles! Use the word bank to help you with your answers.

Max the Monkey is playing a game of Tag-Ball in the school field. To win, his team must move the ball into the other team's goal. They need to work together to keep the ball away from the other players.

Word bank: Dribbling · Passing · Defending · Space · Teamwork · Attacking · Intercepting

1. 1. What do we call it when you move the ball by tapping it with your feet or hands? (1 mark) (1 mark)

2. 2. Why is it important to run into open 'space' during a game? (2 marks) (2 marks)

3. 3. Name two skills you need to be a good team player. (2 marks) (2 marks)

4. 4. If the other team has the ball, what should your team do to try and get it back? (3 marks) (3 marks)

5. 5. Max is attacking the goal. Describe how Max and his friend can work together to score. Start your sentence with: 'Max can...' (4 marks)

6. 6. Extended Task: Write a short guide (3-5 sentences) for a new student on how to play a fair invasion game. Think about rules, being kind to others, and how to win. (5 marks) (5 marks)
