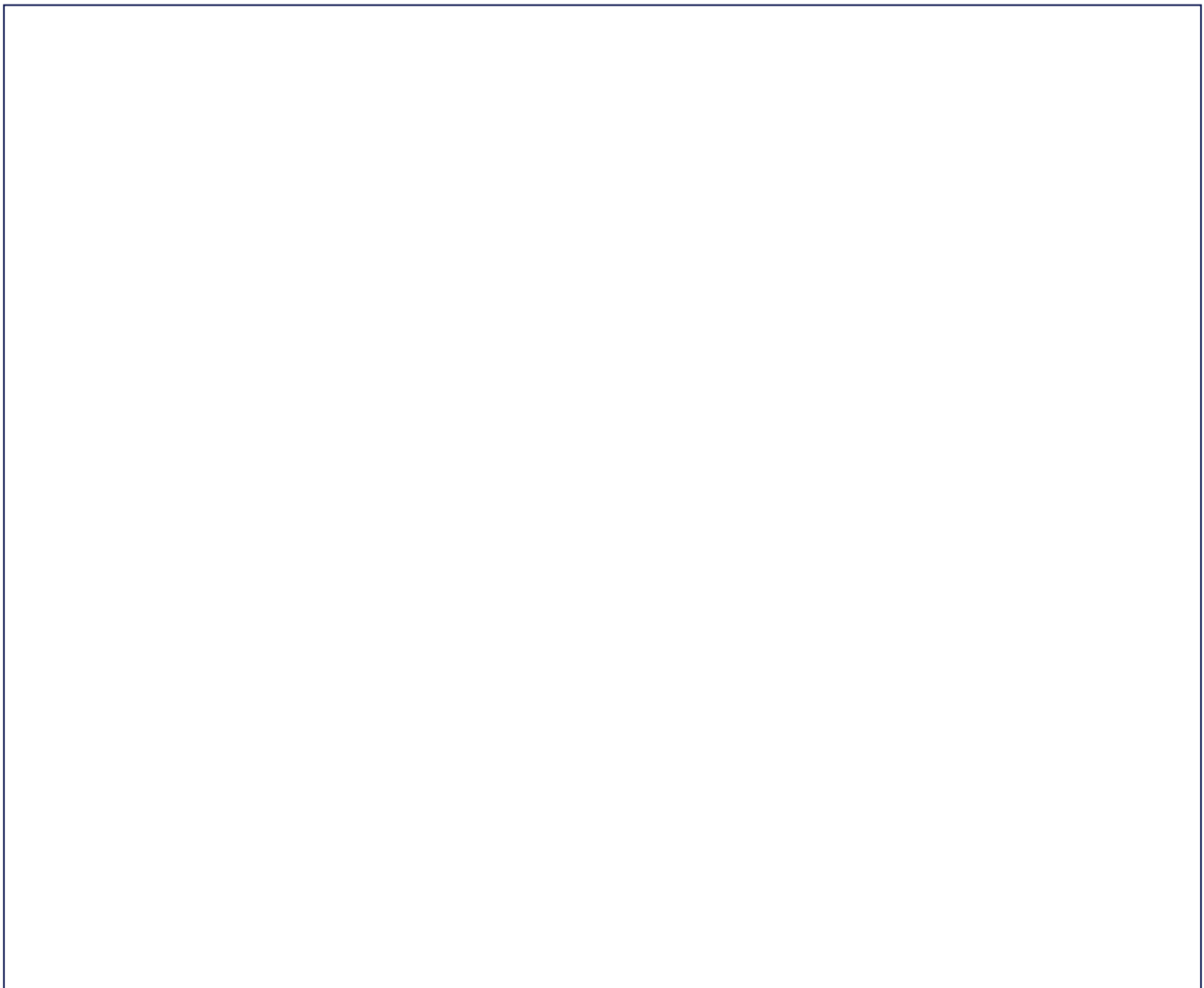


Max's Net and Wall Games Challenge

Learning objective: To understand the layout and key features of a net and wall game court.

Follow the steps below to draw and label your court. Use a pencil and a ruler to make your lines neat. Look at the word bank to help you spell your labels correctly.

Draw: Draw a top-down view of a rectangular sports court. In the middle of the court, draw a line representing a net. At one end of the rectangle, draw a solid block representing a practice wall. Add lines to divide the court into smaller sections for serving. Use a ruler to ensure the lines are straight and clear.



Label words: net · baseline · sideline · service box · wall

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large rectangle to be the court. Label the long lines on the outside as the 'sideline'.
2. Step 2: Draw a line across the middle of your rectangle. Label this the 'net'.
3. Step 3: Draw a smaller square near the net. Label this the 'service box'.
4. Step 4: Draw a tall rectangle at one end of the court to be the 'wall'.
