

Max's Masterclass: Net and Wall Games

Get Ready, Get Set, Get Active! Join Max the Monkey on the court!

- A net and wall game is played by two sides separated by a net or a large wall.
- The game usually starts with a serve to get the ball or shuttlecock into play.
- A rally happens when players hit the ball back and forth over the net to each other.
- You score a point if your opponent cannot hit the ball back before it bounces twice.
- Moving your feet quickly helps you reach the ball and stay in the game longer.

Did you know? Did you know? In many net and wall games, you have to try and make the ball or shuttlecock land in your opponent's court, but keep it away from where they can reach it easily!
