

Striking and Fielding Assessment: Supported Level

Learning objective: To demonstrate knowledge and understanding of striking and fielding skills.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank to help you write your answers. Write clearly in the spaces provided.

Max the monkey is learning about striking and fielding. He knows that in these games, one team tries to hit the ball far away. The other team tries to stop them and get them 'out'.

Word bank: bat · fielding · bowler · wicket · runs · catch · team

1. 1. Max is holding an object to hit the ball. What is this object called? (2 marks)

2. 2. When you hit the ball and run to the other side to score a point, what are these points called? (2 marks)

3. 3. If a player catches the ball before it touches the ground, is the batter 'in' or 'out'? Explain why. (4 marks)

4. 4. Describe one way a player can show good teamwork when they are fielding. (4 marks)

5. 5. Imagine you are teaching a friend how to play. Write 3 sentences explaining the job of the bowler and the job of the person with the bat. (8 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Max the monkey using a bat to hit a ball. Draw a fielder trying to catch it.
