

Kindness at the Garden Party

Learning objective: To understand and demonstrate acts of kindness towards friends and peers within an EYFS setting.

Look at the scene below. Use your pencils to add details of kindness, then answer the questions to show how you would be a kind friend.

Draw: Draw a sunny garden scene featuring Max the monkey sitting on a picnic blanket. Include space for at least two other friends to join him. Use bright colours and draw expressive, happy faces on all characters. Add items like a shared basket of fruit, a toy, or a book to show the characters playing together nicely.



Label words: sharing · helping · smiling · caring · friend · kindness

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a fruit to share between Max the monkey and his friend. What fruit did you choose?
2. Step 2: Draw a way to help your friend if they fall over. What could you say to them?
3. Step 3: If you had £2, what kind gift could you buy for a friend to make them smile?
4. Step 4: Label your drawing using one word from the word bank.
5. Step 5: Why is it important to show kindness to our friends?
