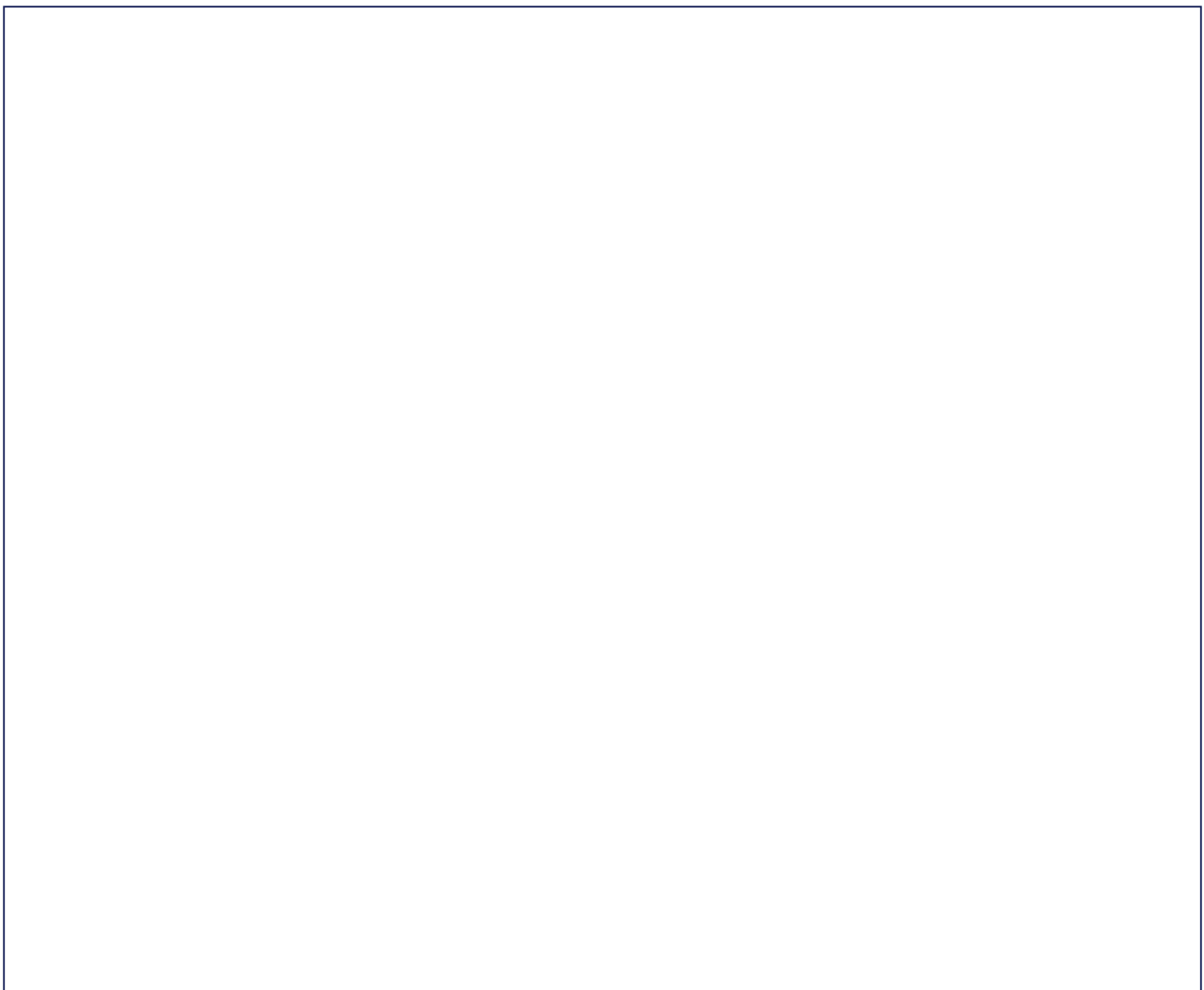


Kit's Digital Guardian Shield

Learning objective: To understand how to protect personal information and make responsible choices when interacting with others online.

Follow the drawing prompts below to create your own 'Digital Guardian Shield'. Use the word bank to label the important features that help you stay safe while exploring the online world.

Draw: Draw a large, sturdy shield in the centre of your page. Inside the shield, draw three distinct 'protection zones'. In the first zone, draw symbols representing a strong, complex password (like a padlock). In the second zone, draw a small icon representing a 'Trusted Adult' you can talk to. In the third zone, draw a scene showing someone choosing to be kind in a message bubble. Around the outside of the shield, illustrate Kit the fox standing guard with a magnifying glass.



Label words: Privacy Settings · Strong Password · Trusted Adult · Personal Data · Cyber-kindness · Reporting Tool

Steps:

1. Explain why it is important to keep your 'Personal Data' hidden from people you do not know in the real world.
2. Justify why 'Cyber-kindness' is a vital rule for online communication, even when you are frustrated with a

game or a chat.

3. What might happen if you shared your password with a friend? Describe the potential risks.
4. Compare and contrast the difference between a 'Trusted Adult' and an online friend you have only met through a platform.
5. Label your shield: Which section of your drawing represents your first line of defence against online strangers?
6. Creative Task: Imagine a 'Digital Villain' who tries to trick people online. Write a short description of how Kit's Shield protects you from them.
