- Sacraments, such as Baptism and Holy Communion, are special rituals that represent outward signs of an inward spiritual grace.
- Christian festivals like Christmas (celebrating the birth of Jesus) and Easter (celebrating the resurrection) are central to the liturgical calendar.
- Jesus taught through parables—simple, metaphorical stories designed to convey complex moral and spiritual lessons to his followers.
