

Who Eats What? A Guide to Food Chains

Follow the energy from the sun to the top of the food chain with Bea the Honeybee!

- A producer, like a green plant, makes its own energy using sunlight.
- A primary consumer is an animal that eats the producer to gain energy.
- A predator is an animal that hunts other animals for its food.
- Prey is the animal that gets hunted by a predator.
- Food chains show us the path of energy as it moves from one living thing to another.

Did you know? Did you know that almost all food chains start with energy from the sun? Plants are like magic factories that turn sunlight into food, which is why we call them producers!
