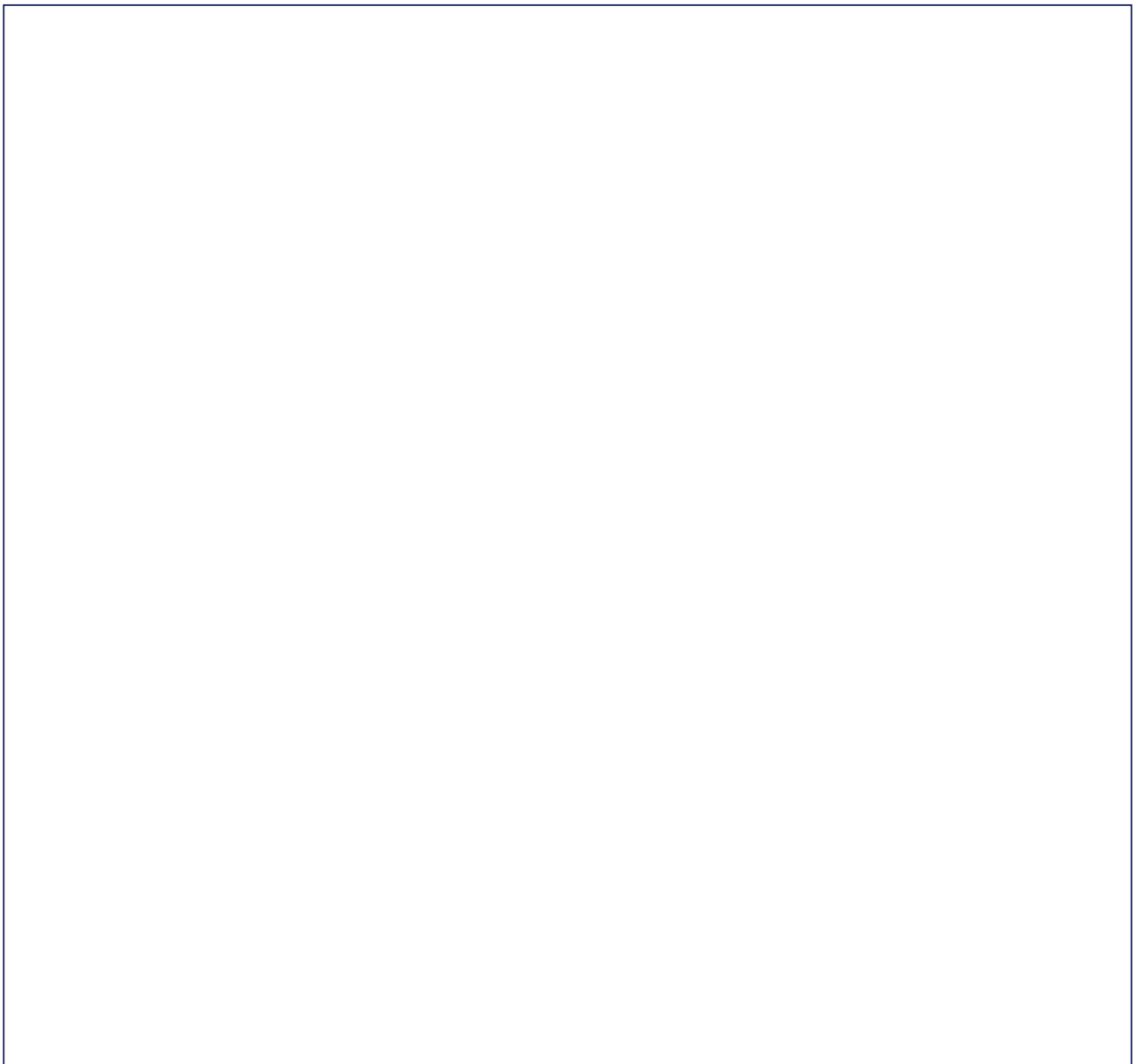


Nova's Amazing Body Explorer

Learning objective: To identify and name basic parts of the human body.

Colour in the picture of the child and Nova the owl. Use your best colours and follow the instructions to label the parts of the body.

Colour this: A friendly line-art illustration of a primary-school-aged child standing in a sunny garden. The child is wearing a t-shirt and shorts. Standing next to the child is Nova the owl, who is wearing a small pair of explorer glasses and holding a magnifying glass. The scene should have clear, bold outlines suitable for colouring. Provide small blank boxes with leader lines pointing to the child's head, shoulders, elbows, knees, and feet, so children can write the names of these body parts.



Steps:

1. Label the elbow on the child in the picture.
2. Label the knee on the child in the picture.
