Learning objective: To identify, name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body, including those relating to the five senses.

Read each question carefully and use the words from the word bank to help you label and describe your body parts.

Word bank: eyes · ears · nose · mouth · hands · feet · sight · hearing · smell · taste · touch

1. Nova the owl wants to know which part of your body you use for sight. Write the word from the word bank below. (1 mark)

2. Max the monkey is eating a crunchy apple. Which part of his body does he use to taste the apple? (1 mark)

3. Name two parts of your body that you use to help you move from one place to another. (2 marks)

4. Which sense do you use your ears for? Explain your answer. (2 marks)

5. Kit the fox needs to feel if a stone is rough or smooth. Which body part should Kit use? (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a self-portrait of yourself. Label your eyes, ears, nose, mouth, hands, and feet using the words from the word bank.



Extension challenge: Nova asks: If you were wearing mittens, which sense would be harder to use? Write a sentence to explain why.
