

Bea's Garden Discovery: Parts of a Plant

Learning objective: To identify and name the basic parts of a flowering plant, including the roots, stem, leaf, and flower.

Bea the honeybee needs your help to label her favourite flowers! Follow the drawing steps below, then use the word bank to label the different parts of the plant you have drawn.

Draw: Draw a large, colourful flower in the centre of the page. The style should be clear and simple, like a scientific diagram. Ensure the plant has visible roots beneath a line representing the soil, a sturdy stem, and at least two leaves. Leave enough space around the plant for you to draw lines to each part for labelling.



Label words: flower · leaf · stem · roots

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a tall plant in the middle of your page. Draw the roots underneath the soil.
2. Step 2: Draw a bright flower at the very top of your plant.
3. Step 3: Draw two green leaves attached to the stem.
4. Step 4: Use the word bank to draw a line to each part and label the roots, stem, leaf, and flower.
5. Which part of the plant do you think drinks the water from the soil?
