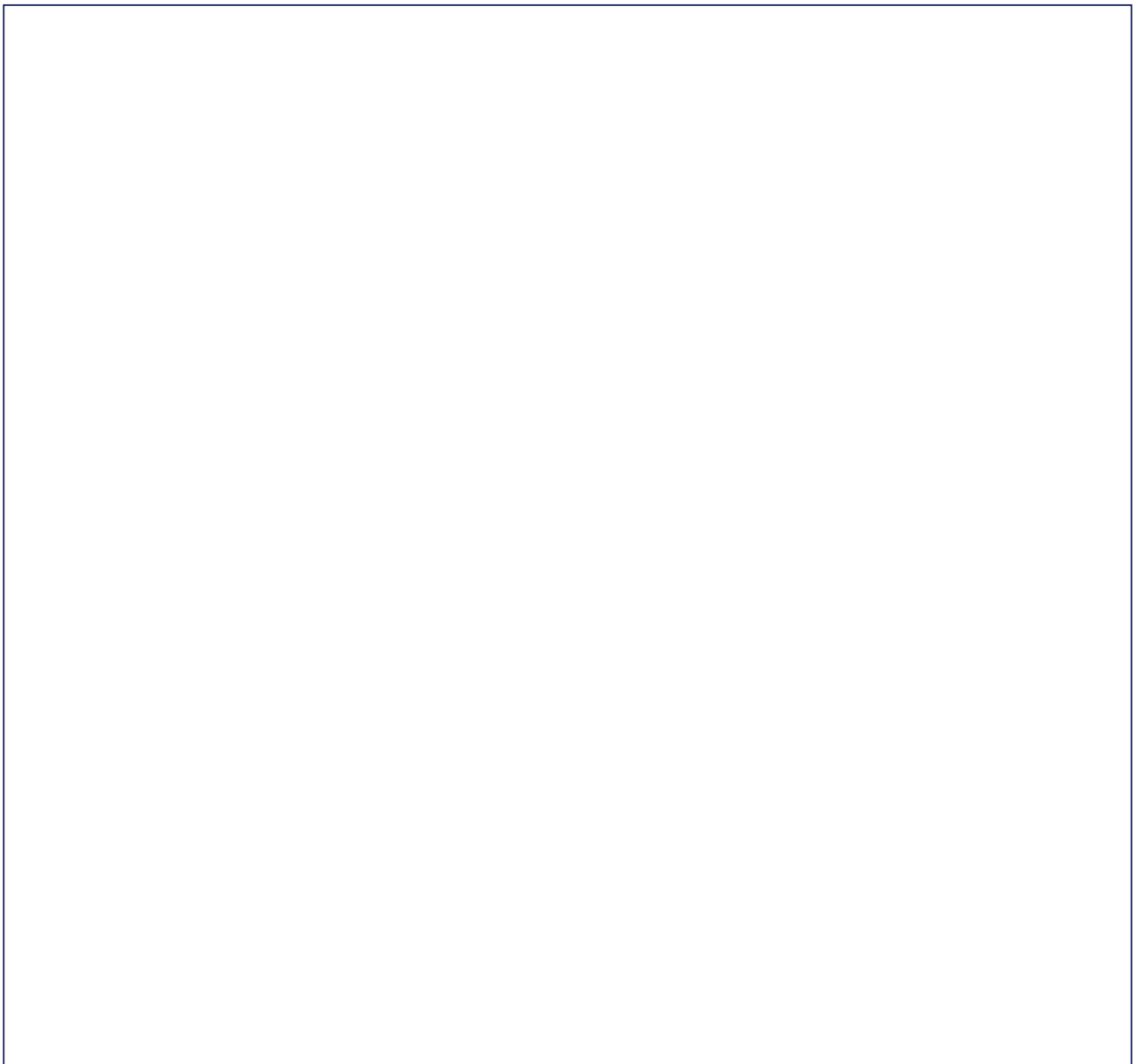


Springtime with Bea the Bee

Learning objective: To identify and name a variety of common plants and observe changes in the seasons.

Colour in the beautiful spring garden scene! Once you have finished colouring, use the labels to identify the parts of the flower and the signs of spring.

Colour this: A large, friendly illustration of a garden scene. In the centre, there is a large, cheerful tulip with a thick stem and two wide leaves. Bea the honeybee, a cute cartoon bee with large eyes and friendly wings, is hovering near the top of the tulip. Steps:
