

Rosa's Spanish Body Parts Challenge

Learning objective: To identify and label key parts of the human body in Spanish.

Rosa the parrot is learning about the human body. Look at the numbered labels on the body outline below. Choose the correct Spanish word from the word bank to label each part. Write the Spanish word on the line next to the number.

Word bank: la cabeza (head) · el brazo (arm) · la mano (hand) · la pierna (leg) · el pie (foot)

1. 1. Look at the top of the body. Write the Spanish word for head here: (1 mark)

2. 2. Look at the limb used for waving. Write the Spanish word for arm here: (1 mark)

3. 3. Look at the end of the arm. Write the Spanish word for hand here: (1 mark)

4. 4. Look at the limb used for walking. Write the Spanish word for leg here: (1 mark)

5. 5. Look at the very bottom of the body. Write the Spanish word for foot here: (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a simple stick person. Draw a line pointing to their head, arm, hand, leg, and foot. Label each part using the Spanish words from the word bank.



Extension challenge: Pick two body parts. Can you write a simple sentence? Example: 'La cabeza es grande' (The head is big).
