

Year 5 Spanish: Fashion and Attire Assessment

Learning objective: To demonstrate understanding of Spanish vocabulary related to clothing, use appropriate gendered articles, and describe outfits using adjectives.

Read each question carefully. Ensure you include the correct definite article (el/la/los/las) for all nouns. Write your answers clearly in the spaces provided.

Rosa the parrot is preparing for a sunny day at the park. She decides to wear her favourite yellow dress, a green jacket, and comfortable red shoes. Her friend Max the monkey is wearing blue trousers and a hat.

Word bank: la camiseta (t-shirt) · los pantalones (trousers) · la falda (skirt) · el vestido (dress) · los zapatos (shoes) · la chaqueta (jacket) · el sombrero (hat) · azul (blue) · rojo/a (red) · verde (green) · amarillo/a (yellow)

1. Using the passage, list the three items of clothing Rosa is wearing, including their correct Spanish definite articles. (3 marks)

2. Translate the following sentence into Spanish: 'The blue trousers are comfortable.' (2 marks)

3. Explain why it is important to match the gender of the adjective to the noun in Spanish (e.g., why is it 'la falda roja' and not 'la falda rojo?'). (3 marks)

4. Compare and contrast the clothing choices of Rosa and Max. Write two full sentences in Spanish describing what they are wearing. (4 marks)

5. If Rosa decided to go to the beach instead of the park, what items might she change? Justify your choice of vocabulary using your knowledge of weather-appropriate clothing. (4 marks)

6. Creative Writing: Describe your ideal outfit for a party. Use at least four clothing items, two colours, and one opinion phrase (e.g., 'Me gusta...'). Write 5-6 sentences in Spanish. (9 marks)

Draw: Draw Max the monkey and Rosa the parrot wearing outfits suitable for a rainy day. Label their clothing in Spanish.



Extension challenge: Imagine you are an fashion designer. Create a short proposal for a new 'Nature Collection'. How would you use colours to reflect the seasons? Write a paragraph justifying your design choices in English. Total: /25
