

Rosa's Wardrobe Adventure: Una Aventura de Ropa

Learning objective: To identify and use vocabulary related to clothing in Spanish and apply it to a creative design task.

Follow the drawing prompt to illustrate your own fashion collection for Rosa the parrot. Use the word bank to label your items of clothing in Spanish. Ensure your labels are neatly written next to each item.

Draw: Draw a full-body portrait of Rosa the parrot standing in the centre of the page. Around her, draw a 'wardrobe' of at least five different items of clothing from the word bank. Use a neat, illustrative style. Label each item clearly in Spanish using a ruler to draw straight lines from the item to the word. You may add patterns like stripes or spots to the clothing to show off your artistic flair.



Label words: la camiseta (t-shirt) · los pantalones (trousers) · la falda (skirt) · el vestido (dress) · los zapatos (shoes) · el sombrero (hat) · el abrigo (coat) · los calcetines (socks)

Steps:

1. Rosa is planning a trip to a sunny beach. Choose two items from the word bank that she should pack and justify your choice in Spanish.
2. Compare and contrast: Why would you choose 'el abrigo' for a winter day but 'la camiseta' for a summer day? Explain your reasoning.

3. Label the shoes you have drawn on your character using the correct Spanish terminology.
4. If Rosa were visiting a formal party, which items from your drawing would she wear? List two and explain why.
5. What might happen if someone wore 'el abrigo' during a heatwave? Justify your answer.
6. Translate this sentence: 'Rosa wears a blue dress' using the vocabulary you have learnt.
