Learning objective: To identify and use Spanish vocabulary for items of clothing accurately, and to understand how to describe outfits in simple sentences.

Join Rosa the parrot on a fashion adventure! Read each question carefully and select the correct Spanish term for the clothing item. Use the word bank to help you.
