

Rosa's Grand Spanish Picnic: Assessment

Learning objective: To demonstrate understanding of Spanish food vocabulary, sentence structure, and cultural preferences.

Read each question carefully. Ensure you use accurate Spanish terminology and consider the grammatical structures required. Write your answers clearly in the spaces provided.

Rosa the parrot is hosting a picnic for her friends. She has prepared a basket with fresh strawberries (las fresas), crusty bread (el pan), and a jug of orange juice (el zumo de naranja). She wants to know what her friends would like to eat.

Word bank: el desayuno (breakfast) · el almuerzo (lunch) · la cena (dinner) · me gusta (I like) · no me gusta (I do not like) · la fruta (fruit) · las verduras (vegetables) · el pollo (chicken) · el pescado (fish) · delicioso (delicious) · saludable (healthy)

1. Translate the following phrases into Spanish: 'I like fruit' and 'The chicken is delicious'. (2 marks)

2. Identify three items from the passage and categorise them as either 'healthy' (saludable) or 'unhealthy' (no saludable). Justify your classification for one of these items. (3 marks)

3. Explain why it is important to include a variety of food groups in a daily meal plan. Use Spanish vocabulary where appropriate. (4 marks)

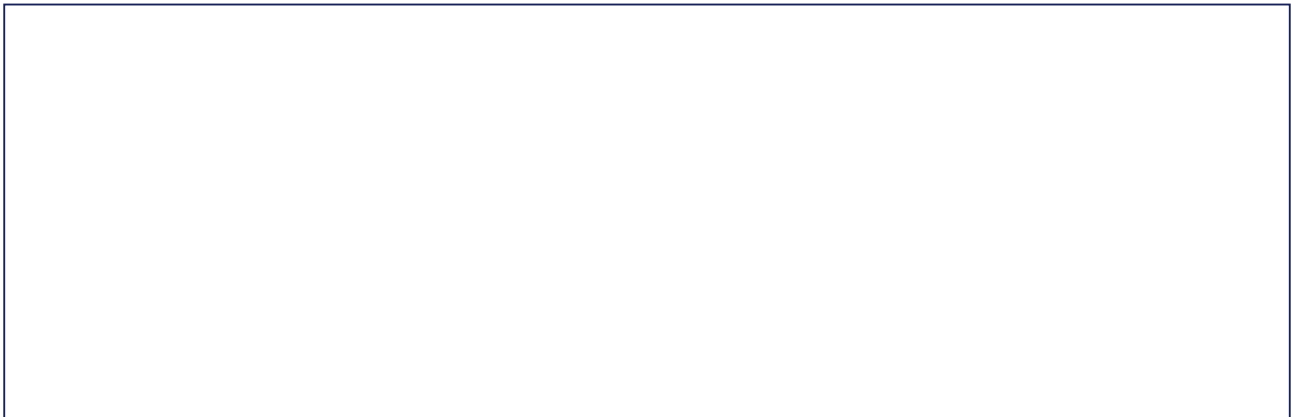
4. Max the monkey says: 'Me gusta el pescado porque es saludable.' Translate this sentence and explain how the structure 'Me gusta' differs from 'No me gusta'. (3 marks)

5. Compare and contrast a typical Spanish breakfast with a typical British breakfast. What might happen if you swapped the two meals? Discuss the cultural implications. (4 marks)

6. Rosa is planning a meal that costs £12.50. If she spends £4.25 on fruit and £5.50 on bread, how much money does she have left for drinks? Show your calculation. (4 marks)

7. Extended Writing: Write a short paragraph (50-70 words) in Spanish describing your favourite meal. Include what time of day you eat it, at least three food items, and your opinion using adjectives like 'delicioso'. (5 marks)

Draw: Draw a 'Plato Saludable' (Healthy Plate) showing at least four different food items in Spanish. Label each item correctly.



Extension challenge: Imagine you are inviting a friend to a picnic. Write a formal invitation in Spanish, detailing the menu and the price per head (£3.00). Justify why your chosen menu is a balanced diet. Total: /25
