

Rosa's Multilingual Garden Party

Learning objective: To identify and use Spanish greetings correctly within a social context.

Help Rosa the parrot organise a garden party! Use the word bank to label the speech bubbles and items in your drawing. Ensure you include the correct greeting for the time of day shown in your scene.

Draw: Draw a vibrant garden scene featuring Rosa the parrot hosting a party. The style should be colourful and cheerful. Include at least three speech bubbles coming from different animal guests. Draw a sun in the corner to indicate the time of day. Ensure you incorporate labels from the word bank into your drawing to show who is saying what.



Label words: ¡Hola! · ¡Buenos días! · ¡Buenas tardes! · ¡Buenas noches! · ¿Cómo estás? · Adiós

Steps:

1. If Rosa meets a friend at 10:00 am, which greeting should she use? Justify your choice.
2. Explain why it is important to choose the correct Spanish greeting based on the time of day.
3. Label the speech bubbles in your drawing to show a conversation between two characters meeting for the first time.
4. Compare and contrast the greeting '¡Hola!' with '¡Buenos días!'. When would you use one instead of the other?
5. What might happen if you used '¡Buenas noches!' when arriving at a party at midday? Explain your

reasoning.

6. Justify why '¿Cómo estás?' is a useful phrase to include after an initial greeting.
