

Rosa's Spanish Greeting Gala

Learning objective: To accurately recall and use Spanish greetings and formal versus informal register appropriate for Year 5 level.

Join Rosa the parrot on her linguistic adventure! Read each question carefully and select or write the correct Spanish term. Keep an eye on whether the situation requires a formal or informal greeting.

Answer Key: 1. A, 2. B, 3. True, 4. False, 5. Adiós, 6. C, 7. B, 8. True, 9. Hasta luego, 10. Buenos días.

Note: Use 'Señor' for men and 'Señora' for women to demonstrate cultural politeness.

Extension challenge: Greater Depth Challenge: 1. Explain why it is important to choose between formal and informal greetings in Spanish. 2. Justify your answer: If you were meeting a new Spanish pen-pal for the first time, which greeting would you choose and why? 4. What might happen if you used 'Buenas noches' at midday? 5. Create a short dialogue between two people meeting at a market involving a greeting, a question about price (using £), and a polite farewell. 6. Research and explain the cultural significance of using 'Señor' or 'Señora' when speaking to adults in Spanish-speaking countries.
