

Rosa's Hobbies Sketchbook: Mis Pasatiempos

Learning objective: To use accurate Spanish vocabulary to describe personal hobbies and leisure activities within a creative drawing context.

Rosa the parrot loves to stay active! Use the word bank to label your drawing, ensuring you include the correct definite article (el/la/los/las) for each hobby you illustrate.

Draw: Create a vibrant, detailed scene featuring Rosa the parrot in a park or a garden. Around her, draw at least four different scenes representing hobbies from the word bank. Use a 'sketchbook' style with clear borders for each activity. Include labels in Spanish next to each drawing, and add small speech bubbles for Rosa showing her enthusiasm (e.g., '¡Qué divertido!').



Label words: jugar al fútbol (playing football) · leer libros (reading books) · tocar la guitarra (playing the guitar) · nadar (swimming) · dibujar (drawing) · escuchar música (listening to music) · montar en bicicleta (cycling) · bailar (dancing)

Steps:

1. Choose three hobbies from the word bank and write them in a sentence using 'Me gusta...'.
2. Explain why it is important to include the correct article (el/la) when learning Spanish nouns. Why might this be challenging for an English speaker?

3. If you wanted to say you do NOT like a hobby, you add 'no' before the verb. Write a sentence about a hobby you dislike.
4. Compare and contrast 'tocar la guitarra' and 'escuchar música'. How are these hobbies similar and how are they different in terms of skill?
5. Justify your answer: If Rosa wanted to learn a new hobby that involves team-work, which one from the list should she choose and why?
6. What might happen if you forgot to use the infinitive form of the verb after 'Me gusta'? Would the sentence still make sense?
