

Rosa's Hobbies: Los Pasatiempos

Learning objective: To learn and use vocabulary related to hobbies and interests in Spanish, and to understand how to express preferences using 'Me gusta' and 'No me gusta'.

Use these flashcards to practise your Spanish hobby vocabulary. Rosa the parrot suggests saying the phrase aloud, then explaining why that hobby might be enjoyable to help you remember the word!

Me gusta leer

I like to read

No me gusta jugar al fútbol

I do not like to play football

Me gusta escuchar música

I like to listen to music

Me gusta dibujar

I like to draw

Me gusta nadar

I like to swim

Me gusta montar en bicicleta

I like to ride a bike

Me gusta cocinar

I like to cook

Me gusta bailar

I like to dance

Me gusta cantar

I like to sing

Translate to Spanish: I like to dance and sing

Me gusta bailar y cantar

Translate to Spanish: I do not like to swim

No me gusta nadar

What is the difference between 'Me gusta' and 'No me gusta'?

'Me gusta' expresses a preference for something you enjoy, while 'No me gusta' expresses a dislike.
