Learning objective: To identify, spell, and use the months of the year in Spanish.

Hello! I am Rosa the parrot. Use the word bank to help you answer these questions. Write your answers clearly on the lines provided.

Rosa the parrot is making a calendar for her friends. She wants to make sure everyone knows when their birthday is!

Word bank: enero (January) · febrero (February) · marzo (March) · abril (April) · mayo (May) · junio (June) · julio (July) · agosto (August) · septiembre (September) · octubre (October) · noviembre (November) · diciembre (December)

2. 2. Which Spanish month comes after 'junio'? (2 marks)

3. 3. Fill in the gaps: 'Mi cumpleaños es en _____' (My birthday is in _____). Choose a month from the word bank and write it in Spanish. (3 marks)

4. 4. Match the English month to the Spanish word by drawing a line or writing the pair: May, August, December. (3 marks)

5. 5. Rosa loves the autumn. She says: 'Octubre, noviembre y septiembre'. List these three months in the correct order starting from September. (3 marks)

6. 6. Extended Writing: Write a short sentence in Spanish about a month you like. Use the sentence starter: 'Me gusta el mes de...' (I like the month of...). Tell me why you like it in English. (5 marks)

7. 7. How many months are there in a year in total? Write the number and the Spanish word for 'year' if you know it (el año). (4 marks)

8. 8. If a toy costs £5 in 'marzo' and the price stays the same, how much is it in 'abril'? (3 marks)
