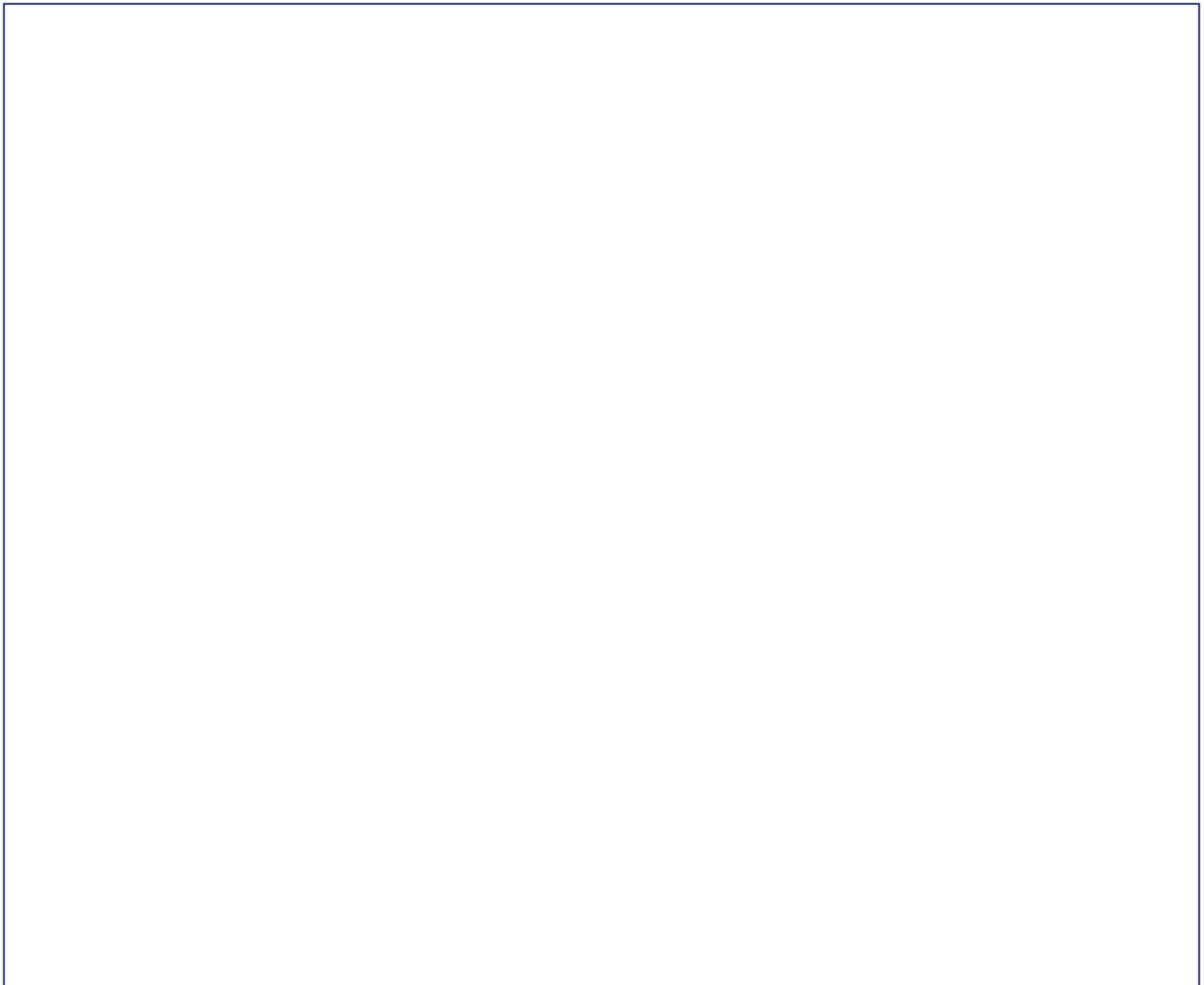


Rosa's Spanish Calendar Art

Learning objective: To learn and recognise the months of the year in Spanish through creative drawing.

Hello! I am Rosa the parrot. Let's learn the months of the year. Follow the steps below to draw your own Spanish calendar scene. Use the word bank to help you label your drawing.

Draw: Draw a large circle in the centre of your paper to represent a clock or calendar face. Divide it into four sections. In section one, draw a snowy scene for 'diciembre'. In section two, draw a bright sun and flowers for 'mayo'. In section three, draw a sandy beach for 'agosto'. In section four, draw a cold winter scene for 'enero'. Use colourful pencils to label each section with the correct Spanish word from the word bank.



Label words: enero (January) · mayo (May) · agosto (August) · diciembre (December) · sol · nieve

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a big sun in the top corner. Label it 'sol'. What is the Spanish word for May?
2. Step 2: Draw a snowman for 'diciembre'. Write 'diciembre' next to it.
3. Step 3: Draw a flower for 'mayo'. Write 'mayo' next to it.
4. Step 4: Draw a beach for 'agosto'. Write 'agosto' next to it.
