

¡Los Meses del Año! (The Months of the Year)

Join Rosa the Parrot on a flight through the calendar—master the Spanish months to keep your schedule soaring!

- The first four months of the year are **enero**, **febrero**, **marzo**, and **abril**.
- Summer holidays in Spain often fall during **junio**, **julio**, and **agosto**.
- The autumn months are **septiembre**, **octubre**, and **noviembre**.
- The year concludes with **diciembre**, which is the final month of the calendar.
- Remember that Spanish months are masculine nouns; we use 'el' (the) before them, such as 'el enero'.

Did you know? Did you know? In Spanish, the names of the months are not written with a capital letter unless they start a sentence! Unlike English, where we always capitalise 'January', in Spanish, we write 'enero' in lowercase.
