

## Rosa's Spanish Number Fact-File

*Learning objective: To accurately use and apply Spanish numbers (0-100) within mathematical contexts and shopping scenarios.*

Rosa the parrot has been flying across Spain! Use this fact-file to help her record the prices of items she found at the local market. Fill in the Spanish words for numbers, calculate the totals, and explain your reasoning to help Rosa master her Spanish maths.

*Word bank: cero · diez · veinte · treinta · cuarenta · cincuenta · sesenta · setenta · ochenta · noventa · cien · más · menos · cuesta · cuestan*

**1. Market Translation: Write the price of a basket of apples that costs £45 in Spanish words. Explain why you chose those specific number words. (3 marks)**

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**2. Price Comparison: Rosa sees a scarf for £32 and a hat for £28. Write the total cost in Spanish and justify which item is more expensive using the comparative structure. (4 marks)**

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**3. The Calculation Challenge: If an item costs £75 and you pay with a £100 note, how much change should you receive? Provide the answer in Spanish and show your working out. (4 marks)**

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**4. Pattern Spotting: Compare and contrast the way Spanish numbers are written for the 'teens' (11-19) versus the 'tens' (20, 30, 40). What patterns do you notice? (4 marks)**

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**5. What might happen if you were buying 10 items that each cost £8? Write the total in Spanish and explain the multiplication process you used. (3 marks)**

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**6. Creative Synthesis: Design a short dialogue for a market stall where a customer asks for the price of three different items. Use at least three different Spanish numbers. (5 marks)**

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*Extension challenge: Imagine you are Rosa the parrot visiting a market in Madrid. Create a 'Market Price List' featuring at least five items with prices above £50. Write a paragraph explaining to a friend why learning these numbers is essential for travel and trade, using rich vocabulary to describe the importance of cultural communication.*
